Laurent Luft - European Assessor

I have thrown myself into the role of European Assessor over the past six weeks and it's with a huge honour that I have accepted the position.

I have noticed on social media this year that many naturists hesitate to purchase their licences from their national federations and ask what the purpose of it is. Each federation offers certain benefits to its members, thanks to partnerships, but instead of asking what our federation gives us, we should be asking what we can give to our federation.

Sometimes I hear, "The licence doesn't concern me, as I'm just a beach naturist" but your beach exists thanks to your federation! In each country, the number of public spaces granted to naturists corresponds to the number of licences sold by that country's naturist federation. If we all stop buying our licences, everything that our predecessors obtained for us will disappear bit by bit. If you're a regular at a beach, you are actually directly concerned by the licence.

As naturists, we are part of a huge family. British Naturism Sunfolk



While COVID-19 limited the activities of most UK clubs during 2020, there were some enormous changes behind the scenes, with British Naturism acquiring the location that has become Sunfolk. The Sun-Folk Society was one of the oldest clubs in the UK, but falling membership numbers and inability of remaining members to keep up with the maintenance tasks meant that it faced closure.

It is essential that we secure the legacy and ongoing Naturist use of the oldest clubs if we are to protect and promote Naturism. It was these objectives that caused British Naturism: Sunfolk to be acquired and founded. The intention is that the Sunfolk location will be regenerated over the coming years to retain the history while delivering up-to-date services that will set the standard for what is possible at a Naturist site.

The greatest immediate change is that rather than being a member's club, the Sunfolk site will be available to all Naturists and better still provide an opportunity for the wider community to come and have a first taste of social nudity.

By delivering an easily accessible, high-quality first experience we are certain that we will attract many to Naturism.

The first year of ownership has been productive; overgrown woodlands have been reclaimed, new facilities such as cooking areas and outdoor showers installed and accessibility for the differently abled improved.

Although COVID-19 restricted the use of the site in 2020, the impact is already being seen.



In 2019, the year prior to acquisition by British Naturism, only 30 individuals used the site, compared to over 500 visits in 2020. The enormous expansion in numbers was achieved despite the narrow operating window and restricted capacity, and shows how attractive Naturist facilities can be and what can be achieved when we open our doors to the world.
